# Purpose:

This event is designed to provide support for Leaders and those supporting the Youth program, to help develop and build knowledge around certain elements of the program, whilst engaging through participation and creating a great networking opportunity. 'This is it, The Greatest Show!'

Where: Glenfield Scout Camp, 2 Cambridge Ave, Glenfield NSW 2167

Cost: \$65 (full weekend), \$45 (day participant - Saturday only).

Note: If Kaleidoscope 2022 is cancelled due to Flood, Fire, or COVID-19 Government Restrictions, an admin fee of \$5.00 will be retained to cover expenses with all other funds paid refunded.

Theme: The theme for the weekend is 'This is it, The Greatest Show!

## What is Kaleidoscope?

Have you ever been to a Konara, Palaver, Pow-Wow, Summit or MOOT? Then Kaleidoscope is for you. Kaleidoscope is a fun packed, networking and informative weekend for all adults in Scouting supporting the Youth program.

You'll spend the weekend sharing and learning new ideas, concepts and talking about experiences that will enhance your ability to deliver and support an adventurous, fun, challenging and inclusive program experience for our Youth.

# Who should go to Kaleidoscope?

Kaleidoscope is open to all Leaders and Rover Scouts from across New South Wales.

# What do I bring?

This is not an extensive list, however you will need to bring the following:

#### Accommodation:

- Tent (Participants will be sleeping in tents, unless you require accommodation for medical reasons)
- Sleeping mat or stretcher,
- Pillow.
- Sleeping bag, blankets, doona (as you prefer),
- Camp chair (optional).

Don't have a tent? Ask your Scout Group if you can borrow one. If you plan on sharing a tent, you will need to abide by the Scouts NSW O&I regulations.



Should you have any medical or special requirements, please ask and we will try to accommodate your needs. Please include this request on the EMS online application form under 'Comment to Event Coordinator'.

Camping trailers and caravans are not permitted. Powered sites are not available, however there is power in the buildings along with running hot & cold water, toilets & showering facilities.

## Catering:

You will need to bring: Mess kit, Plate, Bowl, Cup, Mug, Knife, Spoon, Fork, Water bottle and Tea towel.

The event is fully catered for from Saturday morning through to Sunday lunch. If arriving Friday night, you will need to have eaten before you arrive or arrange to self-cater. Likewise, Sunday lunch will be a light 'packed' lunch only.

# Clothing:

You should pack comfortable 'camp' clothes and comfortable walking shoes. Ensure you bring warm clothes for night, a raincoat in case of rain and a day/back-pack.

You should wear your Scout Uniform on Saturday morning and for closing parade on Sunday.

#### Themed outfit:

Participants are encouraged to bring along a **themed costume**, outfit or clothing to wear to dinner on Saturday night, in keeping with 'The Greatest Show' theme, e.g. Circus, stage show, carnival etc. Be creative, you could win a prize!

### What should I expect?

You will have the opportunity to work your way through fun activities, information sessions & be reinvigorated. There will be information to take away, new friends and contacts, and YES, there will be a badge (and possibly give-a-ways)!

### Program:

There will be a range of information and demonstration sessions on operating systems such as Scout | Terrain and Operoo. There will be fun Patrol activities to try out. Saturday night dinner you are asked to come dressed in your themed outfit and will include a motivational Guest Speaker. Following dinner, you will be able to choose between a variety of night-time activities of fun or just sit relax and network.

Closer to the event, you will be sent a link to complete a survey for you to choose the activities you would like to do. We will do our best to accommodate your selections depending on demand.
