

South Coast & Tablelands Region Jamborette 2022



In the event of an emergency that requires an evacuation of the camp, an emergency siren or air horn will sound. At this time, attendees should follow directions as per below.

There are two **EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINTS** for the Jamborette (see the camp map)

- E1 Parade ground where main flag pole is situated
- E2 Car park cleared area adjacent to turn off to bottom flats near power lines

During Activity Times:

- 1. Remain as a Patrol at ALL TIMES.
- **2.** Head to the nearest <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u>, if safe to do so. If <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u> is inaccessible or not safe, move to the nearest alternate <u>SAFE AREA</u>.
- **3.** Locate HQ Representative and inform of Patrol and Group.
- **4.** Wait at this <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u> until instructed by HQ Staff or Emergency Personnel.

Whilst in Troop Lines:

- **1.** Troops are to move to the nearest <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u>, IF Safe to do so. If <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u> is inaccessible or not safe, move to the nearest alternate <u>SAFE AREA</u>.
- 2. Leaders to take Roll Call of Troop. Any missing persons must be noted.
- 3. Locate HQ Representative and inform of Troop arrival and any missing persons.
- **4.** Wait at this <u>EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT</u> until instructed by HQ Staff or Emergency Personnel.

HQ Staff:

- Assemble Scouts with assistance from leaders in an orderly fashion.
- Communicate with JOC of any patrols who cannot reach a common <u>EMERGENCY</u> <u>ASSEMBLY POINT</u>.
- Coordinate with Emergency Services as required.
