Congratulations! You are invited to attend the Ku-Ring-Gai District Scout Leadership Course to be held on **Saturday 23 November and Sunday 24 November 2024** at "TBA".

The Scout Leadership Course is a National Course run at a local level, designed for Scouts who have completed their Adventurer Level 1 Award. It has content suitable for 12 and 13 year old Scouts keen to develop their skills to become leaders in their Scout Troop. The course has a practical hands-on approach.

Sessions covered on the Course include:

- Being a Leader in Scouts
- Role of the Patrol System
- Planning Activities (Plan, Do, Review)
- Problem Solving, Communication and Bullying
- Understanding and Managing Risks
- The Scout award scheme (Australian Scout Award)

Please note that full attendance is compulsory. Sorry. No exemptions for sport leave.

This is a non-residential course (no overnight camping) and will run from **11am to 6pm on Saturday, and 8am to 1pm on Sunday**. Meals provided – morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea on Saturday, and morning tea on Sunday. Please wear full Scout uniform and bring your camp mess kit and a water bottle.

The cost of the course is \$38.00, payable to Sydney North Region.

If you wish to attend the course you should:

- 1) Let your Scout Leader know as soon as possible. Closes 16 November 2024.
- 2) Register through the Sydney North Registration page – link to be updated. No Operoo or E1 form is required.
