Please note:

Camping sites includes an un powered 4m x 4m site, suitable for a maximum of four people.

- Check-in is from 2pm and check-out is before 10.00am. Upon arrival to the Island, please make your way from the wharf , through the Cockatoo Island archway to the Visitors Centre building for check in .
** Please advise if you arriving after 6pm. Security will assist with late check ins , they greet each ferry as it arrives once the office has closed.
- All reservations must have at least one person who is over 18 y/o staying with them who is to be responsible for all persons under the reservation. There is a maximum number of 4 people per site and site size is 4x4 metres.
- Sites are allocated on a first in first served basis upon arrival and are un-powered. Power is available in the camp kitchen and in the shower cubicles.

- Sleeping Mattresses are available for hire from The Island Campground Office. \$10.00 each
- The cost of transportation to and from the island is not included. Please check the ferry timetable for arrival and departure times at transportnsw.info
- No refunds are issued for camp site reservations. Bookings can be changed or extended by up to three months, if arranged five days prior to your original arrival. After that time, changes or extensions can also be made to any date in the following three months except Saturday's. There are no extensions on rain checks or vouchers.

• Cooking is only permitted in the camp ground kitchen. No BBQs or gas cookers can be brought to the Island . We have a well appointed campers' kitchen with 2 x fridges, electric BBQs , microwave oven and zip hot water . If using the kitchen, please ensure you bring your own BBQ supplies, cooking utensils, plates, cutlery and washing up liquid & tea towels.

• **Alcohol cannot be brought onto Cockatoo Island.** Cockatoo Island has a strict alcohol policy to ensure the safety and enjoyment of visitors. Read the full Alcohol Rules: <http://www.cockatooisland.gov.au/visit/alcohol-rules>

Alcohol can be purchased from Societe Overboard at Parramatta Wharf on arrival and can be consumed in the campground. Each customer is limited to one bottle of wine (opened), and four cups of beer, due to NSW liquor licensing regulations.

There are a variety of Food and Beverage outlets on Cockatoo Island. Please check our web site for details and opening times, which vary each season. Ice is available on the Island for \$7.00 per bag from the campground office
