COVID-19 UPDATE - 25 NOVEMBER 2021:

Public Health guidelines have had minor adjustments since Lockdown lifted and affect the Scout section guidelines below. These are:

- Indoor limits are now 1 person per 2sqm with a maximum density of 20 people
- Outdoor gatherings can now be 1,000 people
