Location

Crosslands is a Hornsby Council own public reserve. It has male & female bathrooms, no showers, and drinking water. Mozzies can be bad at times; please pack insect repellent you know works. We like to recommend Bushman's, but if you have a favourite one that works, that's fine.

- Arrive between 5-6pm
- Please have a substantial afternoon tea, our first meal is supper.
- When you arrive, please check in with a leader and hand over medication.
- Many hands make light work, we need to get all our tents and shelters up on Friday, Scouts should arrive ready to help.
