Date Location Eligibility	 Saturday 29th April 2023 – Sunday 30th April 2023 Camp Coutts, Waterfall NSW. Scouts Leaders and Helpers
Registrations	Units/Groups are to register using the Scouts NSW EMS (ScoutEvent) – https://events.nsw.scouts.com.au/event/921 Registrations Open – 18th March 2023 Registrations Close – 16th April 2023
Camping	The Leadership course has a camping area for Scouts. From this location Patrols will travel around the Camp Coutts to complete bases. Each Scout is to provide and arrange their own camping gear, including tentage, as well as cooking and dining requirements (including food!). Gas cooking is to be used, as no fires are permitted near campsites. All gear must fit into an overnight hiking pack and must be carried by the Scout to the campsite, where it can be left in the tent during the day. A day bag with lunch, a personal first aid kit, water bottle, raincoat and broad-brimmed hat will be used during the day.
Travel	Individuals/Units are to arrange their own travel to and from the Leadership Course at the Individual/Unit's cost.

Fee Schedule	 Scouts - \$25.00 PLUS personal food costs Leaders & Adult Helpers - \$15.00 PLUS personal food costs
Personal Equipment	 All members should travel to and from the Leadership Course in full Scout Uniform. This will also be required for Opening AND Closing Ceremony. During the event, Scouts are to dress appropriately (NOT in their uniform for Activities). All tops must have sleeves (singlet tops/shoestring strap tops are NOT appropriate or sunsmart).
