## First Aid Plan

- 1. Each Scout is to have a Personal First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position for everyone in the patrol.
- 2. Each Activity base should have a First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position.
- 3. Each Campsite must have a substantial First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position.
- 4. First Aid issues should be addressed in the following sequence:
  - i. The Patrol.
  - ii. The Activity Base First Aider.
  - iii. The Campsite First Aid team.
- 5. Contacting of Emergency Services or Youth Members parents will be assessed at the time of the incident following Scouts NSW policies.
- 6. All communications with family on health issues will be coordinated through the Leadership Course Welfare Team.
- 7. All incidents <u>must</u> to be reported whether or not they are a "near miss" or an actual "injury" using an HS-15.1 Incident Report Form. This protocol requires Incident Reports to be lodged 'on line' by the camp coordinator.

Please notify camp coordinator immediately of any Incidents.
